The produce from the garden continued through summer, even though the growing conditions were not ideal. The **SJOS Garden Team** were able to harvest tomatoes, lettuce, zucchini, beans, silver beet, parsley, cucumber, spring onions, chives, passionfruit and a variety of herbs. The compost bin and worm farm are being well maintained and there has been a lot of effort into supporting the young fruit trees. As the season changes, the team is planning the next growing cycle and working towards future plantings, with top up soil needed to replenish the garden. The fresh produce grown is well received by all visitors to the SJOS Food Store
